Essential Duties and Responsibilities

- Surface and subsurface soil and rock sampling using hand and mechanical methods (e.g., hollow stem auger drill rig)
- Soil excavation and drilling oversight
- Waste containerization/shipping
- Collection of stormwater samples, inspection of erosion controls, and maintenance of erosion controls
- Assist in the preparation of project start-up documents (e.g. work plans), daily reporting of field activities to the client, and preparation of technical reports
- Oversee field operations and mentor junior staff
