- Continuously evaluate sites for any hazards not previously identified or adequately controlled, initiate measures required to protect personnel, the public and the environment, and revise documents accordingly.
- Lead daily safety and pre-job briefings.
- Provide or ensure hazard-specific training is provided for project personnel and site visitors.
- Ensure ES&H requirements and goals have been identified to project personnel.
- Maintain first aid and OSHA 300 logs, report accidents and injuries, conduct accident/incident investigations
- Participating in IH or OS audits.
- Provide direct/indirect support and guidance to TerranearPMC, LLC (i.e. Managers, Specialists and Technicians) within assigned projects concerning Industrial and Occupational Exposures and occupational health
- Identify, evaluate and understand basic technical, regulatory and organizational issues and develop appropriate and cost-effective solutions related to industrial hygiene and occupational health
- Assist in managing and overseeing the TPMC Occupational health, safety and IH Risk Assessment programs.

- A minimum of 40 hours of formal environmental training in erosion control, waste management, or other environmental discipline, or equivalent environmental related training and/or job experience
- Current training in CPR and First Aid.
- Knowledge of chemical manufacturing operations and relevant federal and state regulations, including OSHA, ACGIH, AIHA and other established exposure limits and IH Protocols
- Strong knowledge of Emergency Response activities associated regulatory and training requirements.
- Strong computer skills in the use of HES applications and the Microsoft Office suite
- Experience with radioactive or explosives sites is a plus.
